A. RESOLUTION TO BAN SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON SUNDAYS FROM 7:00 A.M TO 12:00 NOON

The State of Michigan Legislature recently amended Section 1111 and Section 1113 of the Michigan Liquor Control Code of 1998. These amendments allow for the sale of alcoholic beverages between the hours of 7:00 a.m. on Sunday and 2:00 a.m. on Monday. Currently, establishments cannot sell alcoholic beverages until 12:00 noon on Sunday. The Legislature has provided an opportunity for governmental units to continue to ban the sale of alcohol from 2:00 a.m. to 12 noon on Sundays. In order to implement this ban, the Township must adopt a resolution to ban such and forward a copy of the adopted resolution to the State of Michigan, Liquor Control Commission by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, December 15, 2010. The Board discussed the pros and cons of opting out of the extended hours for alcohol sales. Board officials indicated there has not been any contact or communication from an establishment in Superior Township to express interest in applying for a permit for the extended hours.

- 1. The Township Board hereby bans the sale of beer and wine and spirits within Superior Charter Township each Sunday between 7:00 a.m. and noon.
- 2. The Township Clerk shall immediately direct a copy of this Resolution to the Michigan Liquor Control Commission.
 - 3. All prior resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby rescinded.
