

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting December 7, 2016

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro, Rose Lang, and Karl Williams attended; new participant Maureen Wolohan was welcomed. All parties in attendance introduced themselves and discussed the work of the Committee.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – Carla reported that she had placed the Superior Roundabouts poster in the library for the month of November and the Non-Motorized Trails poster for December. All binders continue to be up to date, and a sufficient supply of bookmarks is on hand.

Email List/Township Webpage – There has been no recent use of the email list beyond sending out meeting notices. Maureen Wolohan will be added to the list of email recipients. With word that the Township webpage has transitioned out of County administration, Township Clerk Lynette Findley is now our contact for handling the posting of C2PST information.

Superior Places – We still have no recent information on the status of the Superior Stables’ feed store construction. Brenda continues in her intention to track down a possible contact with the Huron Valley Motorcycle Club. The MacArthur Boulevard description still goes unclaimed. Carla reported that work on the wetlands mitigation at the Jack R. Smiley Nature Preserve appears to be wrapping up, so it is likely that a Superior Places profile of the preserve will be forthcoming in the spring. Inactive topics of the Ford Farm and the Township’s Agricultural Heritage were not addressed.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – Brenda and Carla represented the Committee at the recent Superior Township Parks & Rec Tree Lighting event; our role was to distribute programs and to monitor the line-up of children waiting to see Santa, and we were able to display our Committee literature. The event was well attended, and so well received that plans are underway to repeat it next year. Our Committee was recognized in the remarks of Parks & Rec Administrator Juan Bradford. We continue our hometown address campaign, and Brenda indicated that she would contact Township personnel to urge them to incorporate “Superior Township” in their letterheads and business cards. Carla committed to posting our campaign flyer at the Dixboro Farmers’ Market when it reopens in the spring of 2017. Carla proposed that the addition of our inactive topic of an ice sculpture demonstration might be a feasible addition to 2017’s tree lighting event.

Committee Development – Everyone present participated in a discussion of possible methods for further development of our Committee. Rose and Maureen described the Geer School Mothers’ Club as a possible group to receive our message.
