Conservancy Farm, including Community Organic Garden

The Conservancy Farm, owned by the Southeast Michigan Land Conservancy, consists of woods and farm fields which lie adjacent to the Conservancy's LeFurge Woods Nature Preserve. The 99-acre farmstead includes a 1909 farmhouse, the original settler's log cabin (which dates to the 1830s), and an old post-and-beam barn where dairy cows were

milked for many years. The farmhouse now serves as the main office for the Conservancy.

The Community Organic Garden, started in 2005, has attracted strong community support and remains very productive. Over 80 acres of the Conservancy Farm are still being farmed by several local farmers, with the hope of transitioning it into a completely organic farm.

Feel free to stop by any time and tour the farm grounds and community organic garden. Staff is usually available to answer your questions.

To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.): Turn LEFT (south) on Prospect Rd. (1.0 miles) Turn LEFT (east) on Vreeland Rd. (0.4 miles)
