

LeFurge Woods Nature Preserve

2384 N. Prospect Road, Superior Township, MI 48198



The LeFurge Woods Nature Preserve is 325 acres of woods, restored wetlands, meadows, and agricultural land along Prospect Road in Superior Township. Over a 12-year period, the Southeast Michigan Land Conservancy made five land purchases to consolidate the land. The farm fields back up to an old growth forest and are being restored to their natural habitat. The preserve protects a remarkable cross section of southern Michigan habitat types. Trails wind throughout the preserve providing visitors with some of the best wildlife viewing (many varieties of birds and even coyotes have been spotted at the preserve) in the Detroit-Ann Arbor region.

To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):
Turn LEFT (south) on Prospect Rd. (1.4 miles)

NOTE: The entrance to the property is on the east side of Prospect Road approximately halfway between Geddes and Vreeland roads. There is a small gravel parking area clearly marked with Preserve signs.
