Township's Finances Are In Very Good Shape. The Township's annual audit for FY2012 was recently completed. The auditors verified ample reserve accounts for all funds and commented that the Township was in "very good financial shape". Township officials continually strive to operate your Township in an efficient, cost effective manner. The Township recently refinanced a twenty year capital improvement bond that had been issued in 2003 in the amount of \$3.5 million. The Township's excellent AA bond rating allowed the Township to obtain a very favorable interest rate of less than 2% on the remaining \$2.185 million that was refinanced for ten years. The estimated savings of \$250,000 will be directly passed on to taxpayers and Utility Department customers.

Toll Brothers To Construct 32 Luxury Homes On Geddes Road. Toll Brothers home builders recently obtained Planning Commission approval to construct 32 luxury homes on Geddes Road, just north of the existing Geddes Glen subdivision. The site is 30 acres. Township Adopted Revised Open Burning Ordinance

The Township recently adopted a revised ordinance to regulate open burning. The ordinance does NOT apply to the outdoor grilling or cooking of food in a grill, barbeque or other cooking appliances. It does apply to other types of outdoor burning, such as the burning of brush, trees and other yard waste. The burning of leaves is prohibited. Prior to burning, a written application for a permit to burn must be submitted at the Township Hall.

Republic Waste Started New Pick-Up Schedule for Recycled Materials

In April 2013, Republic Waste supplied customers with 95 gal. curb carts for recyclables that will be picked-up every other week. The cart and collection of regular household waste will remain the same.
