#### 10. NEW BUSINESS

# A. <u>UTILITY RATES FOR RESIDENTS RECEIVING WATER AND SEWER</u> SERVICES VIA ANN ARBOR TOWNSHIP

Ann Arbor Township has notified the Board that the water and sewer rates for those Superior Charter Township residents who receive their utilities from Ann Arbor

Township would be increased. The Utility Department needs to pass those increases to the residents effective August 15, 2008.

It was moved by Lewis, supported by McKinney, that the Superior Charter Township Board adopt the following Resolution:

# SUPERIOR CHARTER TOWNSHIP WASHTENAW COUNTY, MICHIGAN AUGUST 4, 2008

AN AMENDMENT TO THE RESOLUTION ADOPTED FEBRUARY 27, 1996, TO DETERMINE RATES, FEES, AND CHARGES RELATED TO SEWER AND WATER SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE TOWNSHIP'S UTILITY DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, this Board is authorized by statute and by the provisions of Township Ordinance No. 169 to determine by resolution rates, fees and charges for services and benefits by the Township's sewer and water systems, and

WHEREAS, Ann Arbor Township has increased the charge for water to Superior Charter Township by \$0.39 and for sewer by \$0.46, and

WHEREAS, the Superior Charter Township Utility Fund may not operate at a deficit, and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the amended proposed schedule of fees is reasonable and necessary for the continuing operations of the Township Utility System and consistent with the past practices and policies of the Township;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Superior Charter Township Board does hereby determine that the fees for services and benefits furnished by the Township's sewer and water systems shall be amended per the attachment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Township Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution, together with the attachment, to be published in the Ypsilanti Courier within 30 days after the date of passage of this Resolution and the fees and charges set forth in the attachment shall become effective on the day after such publication.

#### 1. Service Rates:

B: Water and sewer (including wastewater treatment) rates for Township customers served from the Ann Arbor Charter Township system:

Effective August 15, 2008

Water \$5.172 per 100 cubic feet Minimum quarterly billing \$51.72 (1000 cubic feet)

Effective August 15, 2008

Sewer/Wastewater Treatment \$5.116 per 100 cubic feet Minimum quarterly billing \$51.16 (1000 cubic feet)

Note: All sewer rates and surcharges are based on water usage, except to the extent of water metered through a separate "Water-only" meter.

### B. <u>CONTRACTOR FOR UTILITY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING</u> RENOVATIONS

The Utility Department requested authorization to build an office within the Utility Administration Building for the Accountant whose current office and side room would be used by the Utility Director. In early 2006 the Department completed a needs assessment for the building that resulted in recommendations for remodeling the interior. Due to the current economic situation the Department has not implemented those recommendations. The construction of this office is an interim step toward the implementation of the study. The Department received two bids for the project; the lowest bid for \$3,134.00 did not include the painting and electrical work. The Utility Director recommended the second bid of \$3,880.00 from Haskell Service Company as it would be a complete job. The Department has an established history of good customer service with Haskell Service from previous work done by the company.

It was moved by McKinney, supported by Lewis, that the Superior Charter Township Board concur with the recommendation of the Utility Director and hire Haskell Service Company to construct an office in the Utility Administration Building per the

specifications on the Job Proposal dated July 25, 2008 by Haskell Service Company for a sum not to exceed \$3,880.00.
