

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting September 20, 2017

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Jane Frye and Rose Lang. We were joined also by Township resident Ken Schmidt. Brenda reported that she had decided to submit our annual report to the Board of Trustees in November, rather than October, because of the Board’s heavy agenda. Perhaps next year she will strive for a September reporting.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – The Public Parks poster was chosen and placed for September. While the Fire Department poster is usually chosen for October (Fire Safety Month), it has not been possible to revise the poster to reflect the newest fire engines, so another poster will be placed in October. A new supply of bookmarks has been printed and placed in the Township inner lobby, joining the updated Superior Places binder.

Page(s) on NEW Township Website – As the NEW Township website is no longer new, this agenda item will be dropped, but we will still address items of interest and concern relating to the Township website. Carla reported that she had delivered a flash drive with all of the updated Superior Places information, but it had not yet been posted – witnessed by the fact of the form of the Flying Pilgrims profile. New participant Ken Schmidt suggested the posting of agendas and meeting notes on the webpage; meeting reminders then could provide a link to those postings.

Email List for Interested Citizens – Ken had not yet visited the new Township website, so we attempted to explain to him the function of this option that has been offered.

Superior Scenes Newsletter – Our contribution for the fall issue of *Superior Scenes* was timely submitted, and Brenda remarked that we should be receiving the newsletter soon.

Superior Places – There is no current work in progress on Superior Places. This agenda item will be addressed again when work resumes.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – A supply of the “Where Do You Live?” flyers has been placed in the Township vestibule. We will attempt to keep this supply up-to-date. This is the same flyer that was placed at the Dixboro Farmers’ Market last month, to be in place until the end of the season. The Committee discussed with Ken the current and possible uses of the Township marquee. Regarding the ice-carving demonstration at the December tree-lighting ceremony, Brenda told of the thanks directed to us at the most recent Board of Trustees meeting for our contribution and involvement. Carla noted that she would reconnect again with the carver, Christopher Troiano, in October.
