Cherry Hill Nature Preserve

6375 Cherry Hill Rd, Superior Township, MI 48198



The Cherry Hill Nature Preserve is 160 acres of diverse terrain, including rolling hills, wetlands, part of Fleming Creek, meadow and woods. The preserve is approximately one-half mile square. The land is owned by Superior Township and is open to the public. Some walking paths have been created (look for a trail map in the map box at the main entrance). The wildlife population here is as

diverse as the terrain, with a resident owl population as well as many wetland bird species, including warblers, bluebirds, etc. Enjoy your exploration!

To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.): Turn LEFT (south) on Prospect Rd. (360 ft.) Turn RIGHT (west) on Cherry Hill Rd. (1.6 miles)

The preserve is on the RIGHT (north) side of Cherry Hill Road. The entrance and small parking area are well marked by a yellow "Nature Preserve" sign and gate. There is an unmarked entrance 200+ yards (1/8 mile) east of the main entrance (narrow path by the "no dumping" sign).

Park Hours:

Daily, dawn to dusk
