

Jack R. Smiley Nature Preserve

8080 Cherry Hill Road Road, Superior Township, MI 48198



The Jack R. Smiley Nature Preserve, named in honor of the founder of the Southeast Michigan Land Conservancy, was purchased by SMLC in 2012 and sits at the heart of the Superior Greenway. The preserve consists of a mix of woods, wetlands and farm fields that lie adjacent to SMLC's Conservancy Farm and Washtenaw County-owned Meyer Preserve. Visitors may access the property from either of these two

preserves or from the Superior Township Hall parking lot, immediately to the north of the preserve, directly across Cherry Hill Road.

The Superior Greenway is a collaborative effort of conservation-minded individuals and organizations that has produced a mosaic of protected private and public open space in the center of Superior Township. The planned Superior Greenway Nature Trail will have its main access at the Jack R. Smiley Nature Preserve trail head, which begins at the preserve's reception area, across the street from the Superior Township parking lot.



To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

Cross Cherry Hill Road immediately to the south from Superior Township Hall parking lot
