

Roundabouts of Superior Township

The current favor of road engineers for roundabouts is evident within Superior Township. The first roundabout, built in 2008 at Geddes Road and Superior Road, has proved to efficiently and safely handle an increasing traffic flow at that intersection.

The most recent roundabout addition has been the 2013 construction of a simple roundabout at Geddes Road and Ridge Road to control traffic near the new South Pointe Scholars charter school.

Compared with traffic circles, roundabouts are smaller; they move traffic more slowly and safely, and grant right-of-way to traffic within the circle rather than to entering traffic.



Along with these local roundabouts, the 2010 installation of a series of roundabouts at Geddes Road and U.S. Highway 23 has eased the travel of many area residents as they travel to and from the Township.

To get to the Geddes Road/Superior Road roundabout from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

- Turn LEFT (south) on Prospect Rd. (2.1 miles)

- Turn RIGHT (west) on Geddes Rd. (1.8 mile)

To get to the Geddes Road/Ridge Road roundabout from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

- Turn LEFT (south) on Prospect Rd. (2.1 miles)

- Turn LEFT (east) on Geddes Rd. (2.5 miles)
