

Superior Township Fire Stations

In its early days, the Township was served by volunteer fire fighters. The Superior Township Fire Department went into service on February 1, 1953, with the construction of the 1952 Township Hall. In 2005, Fire Station No. 1 moved from Township Hall to a new facility at the intersection of Ford Road and Prospect Road. Our Fire Department is justifiably proud of the flagship facility, and welcomes the

interest of Township residents. To take a tour of the facility, call the Department's business telephone at (734) 484-1996.

To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

Turn RIGHT (north) on Prospect Rd. (.9 mile)

Turn LEFT (west) on Ford Rd. (151 feet)

The fire station is on the RIGHT (north) side of Ford Road.

Note that a second fire station also serves Township residents. Built in 1976, Station No. 2 serves the more densely populated areas in the southeast corner of the Township. A portion of the building at the intersection of Harris Road and MacArthur Boulevard has been converted into the Superior Township branch library. Because of limited space, this fire station is not open to visitors.



To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

Turn LEFT (south) on Prospect Rd. (2.0 miles)

Turn LEFT (east) on Geddes Rd. (1.0 mile)

Turn RIGHT (south) on Harris Rd. (0.3 mile)

The entry to the parking lot is on the RIGHT (west) side of Harris Rd.
