

Superior Township Natural Beauty Roads

Gale Road, Warren Road, Napier Road

“Natural Beauty Road” is a designation set by established federal guidelines in the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act of 1994. Superior Township has three such designated roads: Gale Road, a western portion of Warren Road, and the west side of Napier Road between Warren and Plymouth-Ann Arbor Road.

The Township has also classified some roads as “Scenic Roads.” The eastern portion of Warren Road, the northern portion of Gotfredson Road, Berry Road, Stommel Road, Geddes Road west of Superior Road, and Cherry Hill Road west of Prospect Road all have characteristics of value to Township residents.

To get to Gale Road from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

- Turn left (SOUTH) to Cherry Hill Road (380 ft.)
- Turn right (WEST) to Gale Road (2.5 mi.)
- Turn left (SOUTH) onto Gale Road



To get to Warren Road from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

- Turn right (NORTH) on Prospect Road (2.1 mi.)
- Turn right (EAST) on Plymouth Road (0.6 mi.)
- Continue on Plymouth/Ann Arbor Road (482 ft.)
- Turn left (NORTH) on Curtis Road (0.4 mi.)
- Turn left (WEST) onto Warren Road

To get to Napier Road (note that only the west side of the road is in Superior Township) from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

- Turn right (NORTH) on Prospect Road (0.9 mi.)
- Turn right (EAST) on Ford Road (3.0 mi.)
- Turn left (NORTH) onto Napier Road
