

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting October 18, 2017

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; no regrets were received. Township resident Steve Sherman also participated. Brenda reiterated her intent to send her yearly recap report to the Board of Trustees in November, because of the heavy Board agenda load in October. The Committee also discussed their distress at the late arrival of the *Superior Scenes* newsletter, seemingly the fault of the printer.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – The library poster chosen for October was Superior Township Hall, showing the history of the current meeting hall and the original hall. As reported earlier, all bookmarks and notebook binders are in place and up-to-date.

Internet/Website – The Superior Township website continues to feature an option for residents to submit their email addresses to receive timely information, but to date we do not know how successful the Township has been in collecting such a list. With the new website, it should be practical to post the agendas and meeting notes of the Committee to Promote Superior Township on the Township website.

Superior Places – In preference to a description of Superior Stables, a Superior Places profile will be prepared for the new Superior Feed store, once it opens. Carla has indicated she will attempt to gather information about the Huron Valley Nighthawks Motorcycle Club, in an effort to include them in our group of Township descriptions. There was discussion of the historical significance of MacArthur Boulevard, but not enough is known about the street to enable inclusion in our Superior Places list. After discussion with Township staff, the recent revisions to the Superior Places posting on the Township website should be soon be entered.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – The possibility of a pre-holiday mailing promoting the tree-lighting event, combined with urging to use “Superior Township” in addresses on holiday mailing, was suggested. The interaction of the Committee with neighborhood associations was explained, as well as the need to better utilize the Township marquee. Since we now have a digital version of the new resident welcome packet, we can add Superior Township Superior Places bookmarks to the packets as we attempt to update them. Preparations are well under way for our Committee’s contribution of the ice sculpture demonstration at the December 2 tree lighting event. We will be able to finalize this at the November meeting.
