A. Crosswalk Resolution

WHEREAS; both Fireman's Park and the library are visited by many neighborhood youths and adults that walk to the location; and

WHEREAS having a signaled cross walk at the corner of Harris Road and MacArthur Boulevard would help insure that safety by assisting all pedestrians to safely cross the street; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Superior Township Parks & Recreation Commission request that the Superior Township Board of Trustees install a signaled crosswalk at the corner of Harris Road and MacArthur Boulevard on both Harris Road and MacArthur Boulevard.

Marion Morris suggested seasonal nature studies, such as owl observation during winter months. This could be especially effective in the Cherry Hill Nature Preserve.

Bernedia Word suggested that her company would like to sponsor kickball teams, by providing t-shirts to the participating children. The t-shirts would have a logo on them, and children could keep their t-shirt.

Nahid Sanii-Yahyai commented it would be good to have a group photo of the Park Commission. Discussion ensued about the merits of publish such a photo in the Township Newsletter. There was informal agreement to take a group photo at the March Park Commission meeting.
