

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting March 21, 2018

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Ken Schmidt and Nancy Caviston. Brenda commented that we should keep in mind inclusion of commercial entities as we expand our collection of Superior Places descriptions. Carla told of a request by Beverly Baker for information on the C2PST – Carla had called and was able to leave a message, but has not spoken to Ms. Baker.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – Carla reported that she had placed the Superior Township Hall poster at the library for the month of March. The April selection will likely be the Parks poster or one of the nature preserve posters. The supply of bookmarks at the Township lobby is well stocked, and all the Superior Places binders are current and up to date.

Internet/Website – There was limited discussion of this subject. Carla commented that she had used the Township website to find information on yard waste pickup dates, and she was able to successfully navigate the site. Brenda took exception to the changing pictures; as soon as her interest was piqued, the picture went away. Carla said she’d take some time to examine the site more intently.

Superior Scenes Article – When an article about the Staebler Farm was prepared and submitted, we were reminded that we had focused on that in the last newsletter. Brenda quickly wrote another article, and submitted a description of the Non-Motorized Trail in time for publication. We are still waiting for delivery of the spring 2018 *Superior Scenes*.

Superior Places – There have been no new descriptions written about Superior Places, but all of the current nominations remain viable.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – Most of the evening’s discussion focused on the upcoming Superior Day event. Although we still have two more meetings before the June 9 event, suggestions for table attractions were noted. We will again offer small soil-filled paper cups to youngsters for sunflower seed planting and display the “Where Do You Live?” flyer and the Esek Pray Trail brochure. We will utilize our map and bookmarks in a location-matching activity. Brenda wondered about feasible cost for “Where Do You Live?” buttons. On other outreach topics, Carla remarked that she had supplied a few more copies of the “Where Do You Live?” flyer to the Township Hall vestibule. That flyer will also be placed again this spring at the Dixboro Farmers’ Market. There has been no activity on the welcome packet or the Township marquee, which is now actively populated with Parks & Rec news. Carla also told of early steps and contacts that bode well for the possibility of a summer family bike ride event.

Committee Development – Carla will research contact information for subdivision associations, with a view to recruit association representatives to involve with our group.
