

## **COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting July 18, 2018**

**Remarks and Announcements** – Brenda Baker and Nancy Caviston attended; regrets were received from Carla Bisaro. Brenda noted that she had not received the June meeting notes, so they could not be referenced during the July meeting. Both attendees agreed that the Superior Day event had been successful, despite an early weather closing.

**Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders** – In Carla’s absence, there was no report on the status of the bookmarks or Superior Places binders or on the selection of the July library poster.

**Internet/Website** – Brenda commented that greater familiarity with the site has led to greater success of information access, although some changes may have been made. Nancy contributed the fact that a new website manager has been named, effective in late July, so that tweaks within the website may be forthcoming. Brenda noted once again that registering her email address with the Township website has brought no response at all.

**Superior Places** – Discussion of Superior Places topics focused on the Michigan Folk School, which has been noticed to be undergoing activity in preparation for the blacksmithing classes. Other discussion touched on the subjects of the Township as a birding destination and the business community within the Township. The imminent opening of an eldercare facility and an ongoing nursing home facility were particularly noted.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – Most of the evening’s discussion involved the new resident welcome packet. Brenda has re-located the material given to her by Nancy, so work can proceed. Nancy suggested the inclusion of a refrigerator magnet card with all necessary Township contact information. Other passing discussion touched on the Dixboro Farmers Market, an information link to the Dixboro-Matthaei Trail, and current Parks & Rec use of the Township marquee. The family bike ride event has been placed on the inactive list.
