## COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – "One Superior Place" Meeting September 19, 2018

**Remarks and Announcements –** Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; regrets were received from Jane Frye. Brenda reported that the C2PST article had been timely submitted for the fall issue of *Superior Scenes*.

**Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders –** Carla reported that the Early Schools poster had been placed in the library for the month of September, and that the poster had gained favorable comment by library personnel. She further noted that the October selection of the Fire Department poster would be brought up to date, illustrating the Township's newest fire trucks and this year's Fire Safety Month motto. Currently, all Superior Places binders are in place and up to date, and supplies of bookmarks are adequate.

**Internet/Website** – Brenda reiterated her comment that registering her email address on the Township website has elicited no response, prompting concern about the purpose of that part of the webpage. She did notice, however, that since the management of the webpage has been revised, the page seems a little "calmer, and less frantic," but she was annoyed by the constant use of Ypsilanti instead of Superior Township in mailing address references. Both Brenda and Nancy voiced concerns about a "not secure" notice they had seen on the home page of the website.

*Superior Scenes* Article – Nancy brought early proofs of the Township's fall newsletter. In examining the pages, we found some inconsistencies in the page numbering system, and Nancy will correct that concern. We were well pleased with the Committee's contribution, and Nancy will make some adjustments to picture placement and column break that we requested.

**Superior Places** – The Superior Feed store is now open, and Carla has contacted the owners for information for the newest Superior Places addition. She also commented that an advertising handout in the Township Hall lobby would yield enough information about the Michigan Folk School to go ahead with that profile. When Brenda is able to source the link for the Dixboro-Matthaei Trail, we can likely proceed with that description as well. We would like to contact local Audubon Club members for information on their attitudes about Superior Township as a bird-watching destination. Other Superior Places in the current suggestion list were not addressed.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – After noting that a supply of "Where Do You Live?" flyers were in the Township Hall vestibule, attention turned to the drafts brought by Nancy of the text for the refrigerator magnets. We noted with pleasure that the Township government has offered to fund this project. Various means of distribution were discussed, including new resident welcome packets, addition to the spring *Superior Scenes* newsletter, display in the Township Hall vestibule, etc. We noted some small errors, and offered suggestions that Nancy will take back to the Township officials. Other items in this agenda category were not addressed.
