

## **COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting January 16, 2019**

**Remarks and Announcements** – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; no regrets had been received by the time of the meeting. Brenda apologized for the delay in sending out the meeting notices, as some technical difficulty resulted in unsuccessful response notices regarding distribution list message attempts.

**Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders** – Carla reported that she had placed the Border-to-Border Trail poster for the month of January. She had not yet determined what poster would be put in place for February. She repeated that new Superior Places pages are currently in the works, and as they are finalized, they will be added to the binders and bookmarks will be made.

**Internet/Website** – Brief mention of Superior Township website use was uneven – one instance was fine and another was difficult and slow.

**Superior Places** – Carla presented copies of the new place descriptions of Superior Farm and Garden, Michigan Folk School and the Dixboro-Matthaei Trail, as well as a copy of the revisions to the Staebler Farm description. The committee also considered the bookmarks extracted from those descriptions. Suggestions and corrections were made, and when the finalized copies are presented next month, we should be ready to add them to our collection in the binders and on the Township website. Because of the time spent on the new place descriptions, other topic suggestions of Huron Valley Nighthawks Motorcycle Club, MacArthur Boulevard, Equine Life, Birds, and Business in the Township were not addressed. The Ford Farm continues to be an inactive topic.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – Carla reported that the supply of the hometown address “Where Do You Live?” flyers in the Township Hall vestibule was exhausted, and that she would print a new supply. It was suggested that we consider some way to distribute the Township information magnets at the Dixboro Farmers’ Market when it opens in the spring. This would be in addition to posting of the “Where Do You Live?” flyer on the community billboard. Other topics in this agenda item were not addressed, since discussion of the new Superior Places descriptions was so lengthy.

**Committee Development** – As we prepare for the publication of the Township’s *Superior Scenes* spring newsletter, Carla spoke of her interest in preparing an article on the concept of what she terms “enlightened self-interest,” or the concept of community involvement because of desire to profit from community benefits. Perhaps such an article might lead to greater numbers of people involved in our committee.
