

## **COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting February 20, 2019**

**Remarks and Announcements** – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Nancy Caviston and Rose Lang. Brenda noted she had received a call from Marion Morris, informing of the June 8 date selected for Superior Day, with June 15 scheduled as a rain date. With attendance diminished by inclement weather, Brenda and Carla attempted to deal with as many agenda items as they had information for.

**Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders** – Carla reported that she had brought all three Superior Places binders up to date with the three new descriptions and one revision (Dixboro-Matthaei Trail, Superior Farm & Garden, Michigan Folk School, and Staebler Farm County Park). She had also delivered a flash drive with those documents to Township Hall for their inclusion in our Superior Places section of the Township website. The Superior Greenway poster had been placed for the month of February, but the poster placement for March has not yet been determined.

**Internet/Website** – There was no discussion of the website beyond noting the delivery of new Superior Places listings to be added there.

**Superior Scenes** – In Nancy’s absence, we had no information on the timing of the spring edition of the Township newsletter. Nonetheless, Carla indicated that she would begin writing the article expected to be submitted from our committee.

**Superior Places** – With the completion of the three most recent contributions, there was little discussion of the remaining items in this agenda item. The subject of birds, or more specifically a description of the Township’s most popular spots for birdwatching, might be our next effort. Carla will attempt to engage the help of a known active birdwatcher for this.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – The supply of the hometown address “Where Do You Live?” flyers in the Township Hall vestibule remains sufficient. We estimated the opening of the Dixboro Farmers’ Market to be either May 24 or May 31, and hope to use their community bulletin board as a means to further our efforts. Beyond displaying the “Where Do You Live?” flyer, we hope to find a way to offer our Superior Township refrigerator magnets at the market. Other topics in this agenda item were not addressed, except to note that there is currently no information displayed on the Township marquee.
