

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting March 20, 2019

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; Rose Lang responded to the meeting announcement. Brenda noted that since the date of the last meeting, we had received notice of the due date for the spring *Superior Scenes* contributions, and that our article had been timely submitted.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – Carla reported that she had placed the Non-Motorized Trail poster in the library for the month of March; posters to be placed in April and May will likely be the Township Parks and Township Nature Preserves posters. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date, and a full new supply of bookmarks will be printed for Superior Day in June.

Internet/Website – In checking the placement of the newest Superior Places on the Township website, we have determined that all three of the newest descriptions have been placed, as well as the revisions to the information on the Staebler Farm. We have learned that Laura Bennett is our appropriate contact for our business with the Township website.

Superior Places – The list of suggested Superior Places is diminishing. Carla will eventually take on investigating the benefit of including the Huron Valley Nighthawks Motorcycle Club. We also discussed contacting Township resident Jack Smiley to aid us in describing local birdwatching opportunities. Further discussion yielded the topic of the Community Organic Garden at Conservancy Farm; all agreed that would be an appropriate addition to our collection. That will leave only MacArthur Boulevard, Equine Life, and Business in the Township as suggestions still under active consideration, with Ford Farm currently listed but inactive.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – The supply of the hometown address “Where Do You Live?” flyers in the Township Hall vestibule remains sufficient. Carla presented three business cards available in the lobby of Township Hall, each now listing Superior Township in the mailing address! As we approach the May 31 opening of the Dixboro Farmers’ Market, we need to find an appropriate way to offer the Township contact information refrigerator magnets in display on the community billboard there. In discussion of the New Resident Welcome Packet, it was determined that we do not currently know what is contained in the packets or how they are transmitted to new residents; Brenda has offered to investigate. Noting that Parks & Rec has announced their summer schedule, it seems that full use of the marquee will be made for the season. Finally, the committee has begun to address concerns for staffing of our table at the June 8 Superior Day, as well as the content of our presentation.
