

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting May 15, 2019

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Nancy Caviston and Ken Schmidt. Brenda shared a Superior Day flyer that had been sent to the C2PST email address.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – Carla reported that she had placed the Superior Greenway poster in the library for the month of May; the Natural Beauty Roads poster will likely be placed for June. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date, and Carla renewed her promise of a full, up-to-date supply of bookmarks for the June 8 Superior Day event.

Internet/Website – Both Carla and Nancy had failed to access the website recently, so there was no discussion of this agenda item.

Superior Places – The list of suggested Superior Places remains static. There was no progress reported on any of the current topic options, but Carla repeated her intent to follow through on Huron Valley Nighthawks Motorcycle Club, Birdwatching, and Community Organic Garden topics as time permits. The Ford Farm topic, currently listed but inactive, could be followed up over the summer.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – The supply of the hometown address “Where Do You Live?” flyers in the Township Hall vestibule remains sufficient. After the Dixboro Farmers’ Market opens at the end of the month, we will pursue placing that poster and a supply of the Township contact magnets on the farmers’ market bulletin board. Brenda reported that she had been unable to make any progress on collating materials for the New Resident Welcome Packet, so there was no discussion of that agenda item. She noted that Parks & Rec has been making full use of the Township marquee for the summer season. Along with distribution of the Township contact magnets, we have decided to again offer youngsters a “plant a seed” activity at the June 8 Superior Day event.
