

## **COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting June 19, 2019**

**Remarks and Announcements** – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Nancy Caviston and Ken Schmidt.

**Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders** – Carla reported that she had placed the Superior Township Roundabouts poster in the library for the month of June; the poster choice for July is not yet determined. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date. We now have a full new set of bookmarks, but the display holder has been put to another use. As soon as new display holders can be acquired, the new bookmark supply can be placed at the Township Hall lobby and the Township library branch.

**Internet/Website** – Brenda told of her most recent use of the Township website to access meeting agenda information. She found the website easy and intuitive to use, posting full information quickly and easily.

**Superior Places** – The list of suggested Superior Places remains static. Carla repeated her intent to follow through on Huron Valley Nighthawks Motorcycle Club, Birdwatching, and Community Organic Garden topics as time permits. MacArthur Boulevard, Equine Life and Business in the Township have not yet been addressed. The Ford Farm topic, currently listed but inactive, could be followed up over the summer.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – The presence of our committee at the recent Superior Day event was pleasingly noted; we appreciated especially the visit from County Commissioner Sue Shink who sought us out to comment on our work. The hometown address “Where Do You Live?” flyer in the Township Hall vestibule remains in place. A copy of the flyer and a supply of the refrigerator magnets were delivered to the Dixboro Farmers’ Market on June 14 for exposure to visitors there. The committee spoke briefly about possible contents for inclusion in the New Resident Welcome Packet as well as the role that packet could play and the places that it could be featured. We have noticed that Parks & Rec has been making full use of the Township marquee for the summer season. We still seek a way to connect our Superior Places notebook with area real estate agents. Carla mentioned that she had presented the idea of a family bike ride event to Juan Bradford of the Township Parks & Recreation Department, and he has taken it under advisement.

**Committee Development** – Currently, our only method of information placement about our committee is on the back of the refrigerator magnets that we are distributing; we continue to seek an effective means of recruiting local residents and their voices to our group.
