COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – "One Superior Place" Meeting July 17, 2019

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; regrets were received from Ken Schmidt. Brenda remarked that a casual statement last month about the viability of the C2PST group bears examination and consideration.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – Carla reported that she had placed the Superior Township Hall poster in the library for the month of July; the poster choice for August will likely be the one featuring St. Joseph Hospital. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date. Carla showed the holder she proposed to use to offer Superior Places bookmarks in the Township Hall lobby. She will use a matching holder to display bookmarks at the library as soon as those bookmarks are printed.

Internet/Website – There was no interface with the Township website reported, so it was presumed that everything continues to run well.

Superior Places – The list of suggested Superior Places remains static. Carla repeated her intent to follow through on Huron Valley Nighthawks Motorcycle Club, Birdwatching, and Community Organic Garden topics, but it would likely not be until the end of summer. MacArthur Boulevard, Equine Life and Business in the Township have not yet been addressed. The Ford Farm topic is still currently listed but inactive.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – The hometown address "Where Do You Live?" flyer will be replenished in the Township Hall vestibule. A check of the supply of the magnets at the Dixboro Farmers' Market should be made soon. The committee spoke briefly about possible contents for inclusion in the New Resident Welcome Packet as well as the role that packet could play and the places that it could be featured. The notion of a family Township bike ride remains on the agenda, but listed as inactive.

Committee Business – In response to Brenda's opening remark, the three persons in attendance examined the ability of the committee to continue. With so few persons engaged in the efforts of the group, substantive activities are not possible. We have agreed to look carefully at the issue over the coming months before coming to any final decision.
