

## **COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting August 21, 2019**

**Remarks and Announcements** – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Ken Schmidt, Rose Lang and Nancy Caviston. Brenda remarked that Township officials were still expecting our work on the New Resident Welcome Packet.

**Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders** – The St. Joseph Hospital poster was placed in the library for the month of August; the poster choice for September is still undetermined. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date. A full selection of Superior Places bookmarks has been put in place at the library and on the counter in the Township lobby.

**Internet/Website** – There was little comment on the use of the Township website beyond Brenda’s mention of the need to scroll down fully when seeking information. The needed information may not appear at the initially shown top of the page.

**Superior Places** – The list of suggested Superior Places remains static, and will not likely be addressed until the end of summer.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – The hometown address “Where Do You Live?” flyer has been replenished in the Township Hall vestibule. A check of the supply of the magnets at the Dixboro Farmers’ Market should be made soon. An initial inventory of the existing contents of the welcome pack was divided into two categories: promotional brochures and Township-supplied information sheets. Township information included material from Republic Waste, Ypsilanti Composting facility, Township Parks, Township Utilities, Neighborhood Watch, and an issue of *Superior Scenes* newsletter, along with a sample of our committee’s Superior Places descriptions. Not present but suggested was a full map of the Township with a diagram of precincts and polling places, some information from the County Sheriff’s Department, and some information about our committee. The brochures presently included offerings from local land conservancies as well as a history profile, bumper sticker, and refrigerator magnet from the Township. Suggested additions were contributions from St. Joseph Hospital and Dixboro Village.

**Committee Business** – With only two persons in attendance, any consideration for the continued efforts of the committee were postponed.
