

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting September 18, 2019

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Ken Schmidt and Nancy Caviston. Brenda remarked that she would send our annual report to the Township Board of Trustees some time in November. In that report she would certainly recommend the use of “Superior Township” in place of “Ypsilanti” in all the instances of mailing address throughout the Township website and in other Township communications.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – The Dixboro and Frains Lake poster was placed in the library for the month of September. October’s choice will be a repeat of the annual Fire Department poster with updated National Fire Prevention Week information for 2019. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date. A full selection of Superior Places bookmarks continues at the library and in the Township lobby.

Internet/Website – Brenda remarked on the lack of “Superior Township” use in mailing addresses on the website. After a contact from a Rose Township resident, Brenda attempted to find information on our website regarding the legal defense millage; she ultimately found it, but not easily. Perhaps not all aspects of the website are user friendly.

Superior Scenes Article – Brenda supplied a copy of the article she had written as our contribution to the upcoming *Superior Scenes* newsletter. It told of an outsider’s experience with our Township’s website, and Brenda’s experience in seeking information there.

Superior Places – The list of suggested Superior Places remains static, and will not likely be addressed until the end of summer.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – The hometown address “Where Do You Live?” flyer is present in the Township Hall vestibule. A check of the supply of the magnets at the Dixboro Farmers’ Market will be made before the market closes for the season. After last month’s inventory and sorting of the present contents of the New Residents’ Welcome Pack, and the initial suggestions of appropriate additions, other likely additions were suggested: info/brochures from Matthaei, Vibrant Life, Plymouth Orchards, Hickory Creek Golf Course, All Seasons Market, WSDS Radio Station, Hyundai America, South Point Scholars, Flying Pilgrims RC Model Club, Superior Feed, English Gardens, Head Start, United Memorial Gardens, and Moonwinks Café were all suggested as likely additions, along with a list of all the churches in the Township.

Committee Business – With only two persons in attendance, any consideration for the continued efforts of the committee were postponed.
