## BAG TAG COLLECTION PROGRAM INFORMATION

### Bag Tag Collection Program

Residents that have a need for solid waste collection but not the Full Service may purchase an official Republic Solid Waste Tag. Each bag must have a Tag attached to it around the neck of the bag. All refuse must be placed at the curb in a watertight 32-gallon bag that does not exceed 50 lbs in weight.

Please place your properly prepared bag/tagged material at the curb NO LATER than 7:00 am on your collection day. Please do not place any bagged waste into cans. Waste in cans will not be collected. Please leave 4 feet between solid waste and other objects so we can service you quickly and efficiently.

Bag Tags are available for purchase at the Superior Township Hall. Tags are sold in sheets of five for \$13.50.

### BULKY ITEMS

Bulky items are anything you cannot place within your solid waste bag, such as carpet (must be bundled no more than 3ft in length and secured for one person handling), water heaters, mattresses & box springs, furniture and large appliances. Bag Tag Participants must contact Republic prior to placing a bulky item at the curb in order to arrange for the collection & prepayment of bulky items.

### YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Residents that have a need for yard waste collection may purchase official Republic Yard Waste Tags at the Superior Township Hall in sheets of five for \$13.50. Each bag or can of yard waste must have a Tag attached to it. Residents may use craft style paper yard waste bags or regular trashcans that are marked "YARD WASTE". Both

cans and bags may not exceed 32-gallons in size and 50 lbs. in weight. No plastic bags will be accepted. Grass clippings, leaves, brush and other yard waste will be collected every other week from the first full week of April through the last week in November.

Grass, leaves, weeds and garden waste may be placed into biodegradable Kraft paper bags. Twigs, brush and shrubbery must be tied in bunches not more than 3 feet in length and not more than 24 inches in diameter per bundle.

### Recycling Collection

Included in your participation with the Bag Tag Collection Program is curbside recycle collection at no additional charge provided that you are a registered Bag Tag participant. Residents are responsible for contacting Republic to receive their cart. Recycling will be collected every other week along with your properly prepared solid waste.

All recyclables must be placed in the recycle bin prior to setting curbside

### WHAT AND HOW TO RECYCLE

#### GLASS BOTTLES & JARS

#### **(Food & Beverage Containers Only)**

Clear glass only. Rinse items out.

NO Pyrex, window glass, ceramics, light bulbs, mirrors, or broken glass

#### METALS - TIN, STEEL, & ALUMINUM

Metal food and beverage cans and lids, rinse clean; labels are okay

Kitchen pots, pans, and utensils are acceptable

#### HOUSEHOLD PLASTICS #1 - #7

Plastics #1 - #7 except Styrofoam

Rinse well; labels are OK

Plastic grocery bags are acceptable

NO motor oil containers

#### PAPER PRODUCTS

Newspapers & magazines including color comic sections and glossy inserts

Junk Mail, Office Paper, Phone Books

#### CARDBOARD PRODUCTS

Corrugated cardboard & paperboard products

Materials must be broken down to loosely fit into the cart

#### **HOLIDAY SCHEDULE**

Unless you are notified otherwise by Republic Services, there will be no collection on the following six holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- July 4th
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day

When the holiday falls on a weekday, there will be no collections on that day, and the rest of that week's refuse, recycling, and yard waste collection will be one day later than usual (Friday collections will occur on Saturday). **If the holiday falls on a weekend, your collection day will NOT be affected.**
