

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting December 4, 2019

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Nancy Caviston and Ken Schmidt. Brenda stated that her annual letter to the Township Board would be sent in time for their December meeting, although in retrospect, because of the usually short Township agenda, November might be better future choice.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – The Township Agriculture poster, honoring farmers at Thanksgiving, was placed for November. The poster illustrating all the Superior Township Parks was placed for December. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date. A full selection of Superior Places bookmarks continues at the library and in the Township lobby.

Internet/Website – Brenda told of her recent attempt to clarify information about end-of-season Republic Waste pick-up schedules. The information was not originally available on-line, but was received directly from Supervisor Ken Schwartz, and then added to the website.

Superior Township Tree Lighting – Although the Committee plans to attend the event, there has been no request from Township Parks for our assistance this year.

New Resident Welcome Packet – No progress has been made on the form of a Township welcome packet, but our intent remains to assemble a welcome package prototype for Township officials.

Superior Places – The Michigan Folk School has been definitely added to the list of upcoming possible additions to the Superior Places collection, and the Ford Farm has been upgraded from an inactive topic to active status.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – The hometown address “Where Do You Live?” flyer was temporarily absent in the Township Hall vestibule, but has been resupplied. In the seasonal absence of the Dixboro Farmers’ Market, supplies of the flyer and the Township information magnets will not be monitored there. We continue to see active use of the Clark Road marquee by Parks & Rec for their activities.

Committee Business – The third Wednesday of each month meeting schedule will resume in January 2020.
