

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting January 15, 2020

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker and Carla Bisaro attended; regrets were received from Rose Lang. Although Nancy Caviston arrived at the start of the meeting, she was unable to stay. Brenda informed us that Laura Bennett, who assists us with webpage postings, was currently out of the office on maternity leave.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – The Esek Pray poster was the library offering for the month of January 2020. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date. A full selection of Superior Places bookmarks continues at the library and in the Township lobby.

Internet/Website – Carla told of seeking information about activity at Geddes and Superior roads that has been periodically affecting traffic. A search of the Township website led seamlessly to the Washtenaw County Road Commission website, but since the activity was not actually roadwork, there was no information listed.

Superior Township Tree Lighting – The event has grown over the years, and 2019 saw a good crowd. Members of our committee attended the event, and were able to offer some small assistance, for which Parks Administrator Juan Bradford sent his thanks.

Annual Update to Superior Township Board of Trustees – Brenda provided copies of her December 16, 2019 letter to the Board, detailing our activities of the year.
