

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting June 17, 2020

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; no regrets were received. Brenda demonstrated and explained our new Zoom remote meeting arrangement, allowing us to meet online for the first time after the March, April and May hiatus. Hereafter, the connecting link will be included with the meeting announcement, inviting interested others to join us.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – The Natural Beauty Roads poster was placed in the library for March 2020; that poster remains in the closed library until such time as the Superior Township Branch Library opens its doors to the public. All three Superior Places binders continue to be up-to-date. A full selection of Superior Places bookmarks continues at the library and in the Township lobby.

Internet/Website – We found news of the opening of Township Hall announced on the Township’s website. Comment was made that the announcement could have come via email to those persons who had registered their email addresses with the Township. No use has yet been apparent of the option to register one’s email to receive important communications. There was speculation that online meetings could be disallowed after the end of June.

New Resident Welcome Packet – At our last meeting, we noted that a Township business directory was the last missing piece for the welcome packet. Carla will contact Treasurer Brenda McKinney, who has said that she could supply such a list.

Superior Places – At the last meeting, a draft of the birdwatching description was presented. We will return to that description, considering suggested corrections. A new suggestion for the list was a profile on Muddy Acres, a commercial cut flower farm/business on Warren Road. Other remaining Superior Places will be addressed as time and interest allow.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – With the return to active meetings, the committee will again turn its attention to the Hometown Address Campaign, our presence at Dixboro Farmers’ Market, and our information placement in various venues. Brenda specifically spoke about contacting a real estate agent, active in the Township, who might have an interest in our Superior Places collection. Noting that we have few resources, the family bike ride event was deleted from our consideration.

Committee Development and Committee Business – These agenda items were not addressed.
