

## **COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting September 16, 2020**

**Remarks and Announcements** – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; no regrets were received. Brenda remarked that Zoom meeting availability had unfortunately not attracted any additional participants.

**Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders** – The situation continues unchanged at the library and at the Township Hall lobby. There has been no possible opening date announced on the library website, nor any mention of groundbreaking for the new library.

**Internet/Website** – Direction to Superior Places on the website is suggested in our fall 2000 *Superior Scenes* article. Committee discussion recommended posting a Zoom link on the Township website with invitation to the public for the monthly Trustees meeting.

**New Resident Welcome Packet** – A contact with the Planning department was suggested for gathering a list of Township businesses. This is the last item we seek for completing a prototype of a new resident welcome packet.

**Newsletter Article for Fall *Superior Scenes*** – Nancy reported that the newsletter is complete and due to be printed. She shared with us the newsletter comments of Township Supervisor Ken Schwartz.

**Superior Places** – Carla presented a first draft of the Superior Places description of the Community Organic Garden at Conservancy Farm. The list of the other remaining possible choices has not been changed.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – Supplies of the “Where Do You Live?” poster in the Township vestibule should be refreshed; Carla promised to visit at the Dixboro Farmers’ Market to check on our materials there. Brenda commented that the Township marquee is currently fully utilized with coronavirus health guidelines.

**Interface with Township Regarding Community Identity** – The Committee discussed possible means to urge Township personnel to utilize “Superior Township” in any listing or appearance of a mailing or return address. With three ZIP codes in the Township, our goal is to emphasize a consistent Superior Township return address on all Township mail and printed material.
