COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP - "One Superior Place" Meeting October 21, 2020

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; no regrets were received.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – The situation continues unchanged at the library other than a spring 2021 groundbreaking for the Township library announced on the library website instead of groundbreaking this fall. At the Township Hall lobby, the supply of bookmarks appears diminished, and the Superior Places binder was not in evidence.

Internet/Website – No particular changes have been noticed on the Township website. However, the Zoom meetings of the Board of Trustees that had been recently disallowed are now reinstated with public access.

New Resident Welcome Packet – We have decided to postpone our request for the listing of Township businesses until after the November elections. Brenda will gather all the samples that we currently have, so that we can complete our prototype as quickly as possible once the business list is acquired.

Superior Places – Carla had only recently submitted the suggested revisions to the most recent Community Garden description. Final approval will be delayed until our next meeting, with submission of the last three Superior Places planned for the beginning of 2021.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – Supplies of the "Where Do You Live?" poster in the Township vestibule have been replaced; Carla failed to visit at the Dixboro Farmers' Market as the seasonal closing occurs soon. Brenda commented that the Township marquee use has switched from coronavirus information to Parks & Rec Halloween activity information. Carla will contact a real estate agent to investigate possible interest in our Superior Places booklet.

Interface with Township Regarding Community Identity – With election concerns occupying Township Hall, we have not pursued this item. However, Carla noted that the business cards on display and available in the lobby all carry the "Superior Township" indication on the mailing address.

Annual Report to the Township Board – Brenda noted that in November she ordinarily submits her summary of our year's activities to the Township Board. Limitations of the coronavirus quarantine have limited our efforts this year, and she intends to use the report to inquire of the Board any projects they would like us to undertake.

Committee Business and Development – This agenda items was not addressed.
