## COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP - "One Superior Place" Meeting February 17, 2021

**Remarks and Announcements** – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro and Nancy Caviston attended; no regrets were received. Because of varying Board of Trustees meeting dates in January and February, Brenda has been unable to present our Annual Report. She also informed us of the email from Clerk Lynette Findley regarding the spring newsletter.

**Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders** – Due to facility closings, the situation continues unchanged at the library and Township Hall lobby. A fresh supply of bookmarks will be printed for the buildings' openings.

**Internet/Website** – The Township website has proved to operate well, except for the ubiquitous references to Township Hall as a Ypsilanti site. The internet has been very enabling, with meetings continuing on schedule through Zoom.

**New Resident Welcome Packet** – No progress has been reported, but we discussed ways in which internet connection to our committee could be included in the packet.

**Superior Scenes** Newsletter – Clerk Lynette Findley has notified us of a March 1 due date for contribution to the spring newsletter. Because of the unavoidable delay in getting the Annual Report to the Board of Trustees, our newsletter contribution will take the form of an annual report to the townspeople of Superior Township. Other aspects of the report will go to the Board in the usual manner.

**Superior Places** – Birds in Superior Township, Muddy Acres Flower Farm, and Community Organic Garden at Conservancy Farm are ready to submit to the website; a new description of the early Panama and Superior hamlets is waiting for illustration. Other longstanding suggestions for Superior Places descriptions were not addressed.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – Brenda will check on supplies of the "Where Do You Live?" poster in the Township vestibule and resupply if necessary; Dixboro Farmers' Market will remain on the agenda but inactive until its 2021 spring re-opening; the Township marquee use has been switched to coronavirus information. Corona virus restrictions have limited our participation in Township events.

**Interface with Township Regarding Community Identity/Annual Report** – As noted in her remarks, Brenda has not been able yet to inquire about the Board's interest in our committee or to submit our Annual Report. She hopes to accomplish these tasks in March.
