

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place” Meeting June 16, 2021 (via Zoom)

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker and Nancy Caviston attended; Carla Bisaro sent regrets. Brenda Baker will take meeting notes. Though unable to attend the meeting, Carla is still able to forward the latest Superior Places to the Township for placement on the Township website.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – With COVID closings, the situation continues unchanged at the library. Re-opening of the Superior Township branch is planned for sometime in July, so we expect to be able to resume our presence there at that time. When the library as well as Township Hall reopens, we will have to check the binders there to ensure that they are up to date. Those closings also affect the placement of bookmarks, which will need to be addressed.

Internet/Website – Nothing new to report.

New Resident Welcome Packet – Advice was received from Laura Bennett that no Township department has a list of businesses in the Township. Nancy suggested asking Washtenaw County; we might also try community groups in Dixboro, or organizations such as the Better Business Bureau. Nancy suggested that we prepare a prototype Welcome Packet for the Township Board to review.

Superior Places – Since the latest batch of Superior Place descriptions has now been submitted, the next Superior Place actively under development is Corn Stand(s). We need to determine if the corn stand on Harris Road is the only one in the Township, or if there are others and these should be treated as a group. Other suggested Places options are on hold until research becomes available.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – Supplies of the “Where Do You Live?” poster in the Township vestibule have been replenished. The Dixboro Farmers’ Market is open, but no volunteer has been available during Market hours to update our posted materials. The Township marquee is enjoying heavy usage, mostly by the Parks & Rec Department. Brenda spoke of a local realtor who may be able to offer insight into how realtors might help get word of the unique attributes of our Township to residents before they are residents.

Interface with Township Regarding Community Identity – There was no action on this item.

Annual Report to the Township Board – Brenda plans to deliver our “annual” report to the Board at the June Board meeting.
