

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place”

Meeting October 20, 2021

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro, Nancy Caviston and Margery Dosey attended; no regrets were received. Brenda told of a meeting she had with Supervisor Ken Schwartz that she would cover later in the agenda.

Attendees Introduce Themselves – Brenda, Carla and Nancy introduced themselves to Margery, noting their years of residence in the community and involvement with the committee; Margery in turn introduced herself, noting her residence in the Township and involvement with other community organizations.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – The status of binders and the library display remains unchanged; the current bookmarks were distributed for all to examine before Nancy will reprint a fresh supply.

Internet/Website – Margery told of her involvement with the website she manages for Friends of Peninsular Park, exhibiting a familiarity with the internet and websites that other committee members lack.

New Resident Welcome Packet – There was no discussion of this project while we still attempt to look for a source for a listing of Superior Township businesses.

Superior Places – There was no progress reported on any of the proposed topics, but Margery commented that the content of existing Superior Places profiles would work well on Facebook.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – Copies of the “Where Do You Live?” poster in the Township vestibule will be refreshed. Margery suggested that Facebook might provide a Dixboro Farmers Market connection. The Township marquee has been fully utilized by the Parks & Rec Department over the last few months. A real estate provider response to our inquiry suggested an interactive map of the Township.

Interface with Township Regarding Community Identity – Brenda told of a conference with Township Supervisor Ken Schwartz and Deputy Supervisor Laura Bennett where she learned of legal ramifications to the use of Ypsilanti in the mailing address on Township documents.

Committee Business and Development – Carla reported that she had given information about the committee to members present at the Hunters Creek Home Owners annual meeting.
