Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro, and Carole Hann attended; no regrets were received.

Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – There has been no activity on any of these topics. Carla questioned work on revising the bookmarks as we segue to digital content, but the group decided to continue with revising the bookmarks.

Internet, Websites, Social Media – Township personnel have been contacted about the possibility of a Township Facebook page, and their response is pending. Might Margery do a mock-up to help them decide? Both Facebook and an interactive map are still on hold.

New Resident Welcome Packet – The committee discussed this at length, and received Carole’s list of Township businesses as a good start. Other suggestions included a welcoming letter from the Township Supervisor, coupons from local businesses, and trail guides to the area’s nature preserves.
