The Red Arrow Motel on Plymouth Road in Dixboro has been in operation since 1954; the motel's current owner/management dates to 1977. It was built by Martin and Elsie Wolf on the site of their original business, The Prop Drive-In, which had been identified by propellers from the World War II Willow Run bomber factory. When Mr. Wolf remodeled the drive-in to build the motel, he named it originally Wolf's Red Arrow Motel, in a note of respect to the 32nd Infantry Red Arrow Division of Michigan and Wisconsin. (There is a similar Red Arrow Motel in Paw Paw, Michigan.)

Mr. Wolf had been a member of the Teamsters union, and much of the construction was accomplished with help from his union brotherhood. He and Jimmy Hoffa had worked together in the 1930s at a Kroger store in Detroit.
