BAG TAG COLLECTION PROGRAM

Residents that have a need for solid waste collection but not the full service may purchase official GFL Solid Waste Tags. Each bag must have a Tag attached to it around the neck of the bag. All refuse must be placed at the curb in a watertight 32-gallon bag that does not exceed 50 lbs. in weight.

Please place your properly prepared bag/tagged material at the curb NO LATER than 7:00 am on your collection day. Please do not place any bagged waste into cans. Waste in cans will not be collected. Please leave four feet between solid waste and other objects so we can service you quickly and efficiently.

Bag Tags are available for purchase at the Superior Township Hall. Tags are sold in sheets of five for \$15.00.

RECYCLING COLLECTION

Unfortunately, there will no longer be curbside recycling collection for those participating in the Bag Tag Collection Program. The Township will have two recycling bins located at the Township Hall, 3040 N. Prospect Rd. Ypsilanti 48198 and Fire Station #2, 8975 MacArthur Blvd. Ypsilanti 48198.

BULK ITEMS

Residents no longer need to schedule a bulk item pickup. Residents should place no more than two items of bulk materials (such as a mattress, sofa, etc.) next to a cart at any one collection.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Residents that have a need for yard waste collection may purchase official GFL Yard Waste Tags at the Superior Township Hall in sheets of five for \$15.00. Each bag or can of yard waste must have a Tag attached to it. Residents may use Kraft-style paper yard waste bags or regular trashcans that are marked "YARD WASTE." Both cans and bags may not exceed 32-gallons in size and 50 lbs. in weight. No plastic bags will be accepted.

Grass clippings, leaves, brush, and other yard waste will be collected every other week (opposite of recycling weeks) from the first full week of April through the last full week of November.

Grass, leaves, weeds, and garden waste may be placed into biodegradable Kraft paper bags. Twigs, brush, and shrubbery must be tied in bunches not more than three feet in length and not more than 24 inches in diameter per bundle.

WHAT AND HOW TO RECYCLE

Plastic Recycling:

Includes all CLEANED plastic bottles and jars #1 to #7: soft drink bottles, milk jugs, detergent bottles, FLATTENED cartons, etc. Check the bottom of the container. If you see the recycling symbol with a #1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7 in the center, it is acceptable. NO STYROFOAM.

Metal Recycling:

Includes aluminum cans, pie and baking pans, tin cans, steel food containers, EMPTY aerosol cans, and lids. Metal beverage cans, baking tins, foil, and food containers are also included in this material category.

All items must be CLEAN OF FOOD.

Cardboard Recycling:

Includes corrugated cardboard, shipping boxes, cereal and dry food boxes, shoe boxes, tissue boxes, moving boxes, detergent boxes, soda/beer cartons, and paper towel/toilet tissue rolls. All boxes MUST BE FLATTENED for proper disposal.

Paper Recycling:

Includes newspapers, inserts, labels, magazines, catalogs, paperback books, manila folders, letterhead, notebook paper (no backings), computer paper, envelopes (with windows), coupon books, index cards, calendars, and brown paper bags. NO SHREDDED PAPER.

Glass Recycling:

Bottles and jars – lids must be REMOVED and separated, and the item must be CLEANED of all food and liquid waste before being placed inside the container.
