To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

Turn RIGHT (north) on Prospect Rd. (0.9 miles)

Turn LEFT (west) on Ford Rd/M-153 (0.6 miles)

Turn LEFT (west) on Ford Rd (1.6 miles)

Turn LEFT (south) on Plymouth Rd (0.6 miles)

Turn LEFT (south) on Cherry Hill Rd (0.4 miles)
