In 2006, voters in central and eastern Superior Township voted to become a part of the Ypsilanti District Library. The Ann Arbor District Library had long served residents of the western part of the township, and the Plymouth-Canton District Library served only a small portion of residents along the eastern border.

Renovation of the community room at the Harris Road Fire Department substation began in 2006, and the library opened in 2007, with 2300 items in its collection. The library also offers four computer terminals with Internet connection as well as research databases, and craft and story times for youngsters. Service was provided originally for 20 hours per week, then extended in January 2008 to 24 hours per week, in 2011, expanded to 32 hours per week, and currently, to 40 hours of service to residents. Construction is underway for a new library on Harris Road, scheduled to open in 2022.

To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

Turn LEFT (south) on Prospect Rd. (2.0 miles)

Turn LEFT (east) on Geddes Rd. (1.0 mile)

Turn RIGHT (south) on Harris Rd. (0.3 mile)

The entry to the parking lot is on the right (west) side of Harris Rd. The entry door to the library faces MacArthur Blvd.

Library hours are Mon, 10am - 6pm; Tues, 9am - 5pm; Wed, 2pm - 6pm; Thurs, 9am - 5pm; Fri, 9am - 1pm; Sat, 10am - 6pm. Drop boxes are available 24/7.
