St. Joseph Mercy Hospital is a 537-bed teaching hospital complex located on a 340-acre campus in the southwest corner of Superior Township. Sponsored by Catholic Health Ministries, and a member of Trinity Health, St. Joseph has been named as a Top 100 Hospital in a variety of clinical specialty areas, including oncology, cardiovascular,

neurosciences, women and children, orthopedics and senior health. It is part of a regional health system that spans five counties in southeastern Michigan. The 11-story East Tower – the tallest building in our township – opened in 2007, joining a surgery pavilion completed in 2006. North Tower, the newest patient facility, was added in 2010.

Although the mailing address for the hospital is on McAuley Drive, there are four entrances to the hospital area. Two drives enter from westbound Clark Road, and two enter from northbound Huron River Drive (see inset map). Each entrance has signs with directions to the Emergency Room as well as other hospital areas.



To get here from the Superior Township Hall (3040 N. Prospect Rd.):

- Turn LEFT (south) onto Prospect Rd. (2.1 miles)
- Turn RIGHT (west) onto Geddes Rd. (1.6 miles)
- Turn LEFT (south) onto Superior Rd. (1.2 miles)
- Turn RIGHT (west) onto Huron River Dr. (0.6 mile)
- Turn RIGHT (north) onto McAuley Dr.

As you proceed on McAuley Drive, follow directional signs to the various treatment areas or to your destination of choice.
