Library Display/Bookmarks/Superior Places Binders – Carla reported on the library "book brigade," a community effort to transfer books from the old library to the new. She confirmed that corrections had been made to the supply of bookmarks and the Superior Places binders.

Internet, Websites, Social Media – Margery reported on Facebook statistics as our presence gets underway. A schedule of new postings has been set up for the rest of the year, with new content added weekly. A Township branding has been set up, so that all Township offerings follow a set style.
