

## **COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place”**

### **Meeting July 19, 2023**

**Remarks and Announcements** – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro, Nancy Caviston, Margery Dosey, Carole Hann, and Katie Russo attended; regrets were received from Ken Schmidt. In this section of the agenda, the committee discussed the relationship between our committee and the Board of Trustees. Methods of reimbursement for personal expenditures were also discussed. The need for a specific liaison at Township Hall was stressed.

**Library Display** – There has been no further word from the Ypsilanti District Superior Township library regarding the 30” x 36” display board. Carla will inquire of Mary Garboden when to expect its arrival.

**Internet, Websites, Social Media** – Margery went briefly over her report, which had been sent to C2PST members in advance. She noted that she had sent copies of the QRS cards, now containing both Facebook and Instagram information, to Juan Bradford for use by Superior Township Parks & Recreation Department.

**New Resident Welcome Packet** – Carole noted that she had also sent her report by email in advance of the meeting. She had checked all the given links and referred to a need for a greater showing of Instagram (and possibly Nextdoor). This again shows a need for a specific contact for website issues.

**How to Build Our Committee** – The committee listed and discussed many of the efforts we have made to build our group, noting that we would desire front-page recognition on the Township website.

**Superior Places** – Carla announced that she had updated all the Superior Places listings, and with some help would be turning over the updated material to the Township for posting.

**Superior Neighborhoods** – Brenda gave Bromley Park as an example of a “neighborhood,” noting that the term could refer to clusters other than subdivisions in our Facebook township material. Once a starter list can be compiled, we will address this possibility.

**Events, Outreach and Community Pride** – After a weather delay, Margery has proposed that she and her assistant Mara Sciabassi would still visit the Dixboro Farmer’s Market for live streaming. Meanwhile, our presence in the Township Hall vestibule remains complete.
