

COMMITTEE TO PROMOTE SUPERIOR TOWNSHIP – “One Superior Place”

Meeting August 16, 2023

Remarks and Announcements – Brenda Baker, Carla Bisaro, Nancy Caviston, and Carole Hann attended; regrets were received from Margery Dosey and Katie Russo. Brenda apologized for having sent the wrong agenda with the meeting announcement, noting that the correct agenda was now posted.

Library Display – There has been no further word from the Ypsilanti District Superior Township library regarding the display board. A call to the library yielded information that Mary Garboden was away on vacation.

Internet, Websites, Social Media – In Margery’s absence, not much information was available about the status of our social media arrangements on the internet. Carole commented that the Superior Township Facebook feed was not coming through on her personal Facebook account. She reported only two calls, both “spam” solicitations, to our email address. Reference to communications to/from Washtenaw County Parks & Rec will be removed from our agenda until such time as it is needed.

New Resident Welcome Packet – Carole noted that the Welcome page was now working, and pointed out Nancy’s role in the addition of the committee’s contact information on the webpage. Landis Smith has been confirmed as our Township contact for webpage matters.

Interface with Officials – Laura Bennett and Landis Smith are identified as our Township contacts for internet matters.

How to Build Our Committee – Even though announcement of our meetings is listed within the Township website, all agreed a more prominent listing, including time, place and Zoom link, would be desired. It was noted that Board of Trustees meetings are being shown on the Utility Building Marquee.

Superior Places – Carla announced that she had updated all the Superior Places listings, offered committee inspection, and confirmed that Laura Bennett was the correct person to receive the updated files.

Superior Neighborhoods – Brenda showed a listing of known neighborhoods compiled by the Nextdoor social media. She illustrated how the areas were identified on a Nextdoor map.

Events, Outreach and Community Pride – The address campaign remains quietly active along with other displays in the Township Hall vestibule. We have no information yet about the proposed livestreaming at the Dixboro Farmers’ Market.

Interface with Local Realtors – This agenda topic was replaced by Nancy’s comments regarding an invitation from the Township government for committee members to submit claims for reimbursement for any personal expenditures on behalf of C2PST.
