IMPORTANT! UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION IN OAKBROOK

Highlights

- Construction work in the Oakbrook neighborhood is scheduled to begin the **week of September 14, 2026**. The work is expected to continue for approximately 8 weeks.
- Work includes enhancing existing sidewalk ramps in select neighborhoods throughout Superior Township to meet American Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance.
- The project work is sponsored by Superior Township.
- The work on this project will be performed by C & D Hughes, Inc. of Charlotte, Michigan; and will be inspected by OHM Advisors.
- Normal work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday thru Saturday.

Traffic, Parking & Access

- Intermittent closures of sidewalk ramps will occur.
- Intermittent lane closures may occur.
- One lane of travel will be maintained throughout the duration of the project. Please use caution when driving in the construction zone.
- Access to your driveway will be maintained. If paving work is planned in the immediate vicinity of your driveway, or an unforeseen circumstance of interrupted access occurs, you will receive notice beforehand.
- Construction equipment and material will be stored within the public right-of-way.

Work may be delayed due to weather and conditions in the field. Expect dust, noise, and other disruptions. We would like to thank you in advance for your patience and cooperation during the project.
